Be part of a three person team.

Get paid \$12/hour for 480 hours
(Mid May– early August)
plus travel expenses.

Provided housing. Accommodations can be local
community colleges or other places allowing
teams to live together.

Meet with regional directors (supervisors) prior
to the start of the internship for orientation
and planning the summer experience.
Applicant interviews are in November.

Student eligibility:

At least 2.5 GPA. Must be an Iowa State
University undergraduate sophomore, junior,
or senior the fall semester following the
summer internship in the Colleges of Human
Sciences, Agriculture and Life Sciences,
Liberal Arts and Sciences, or Design.

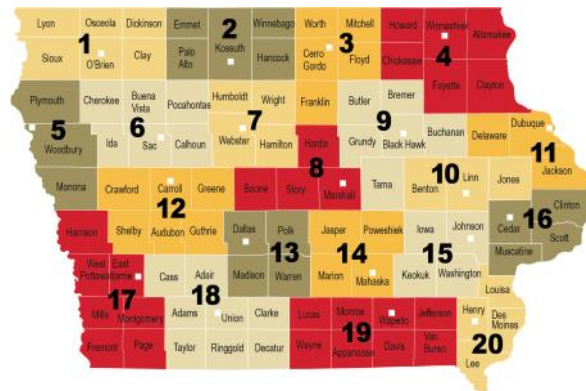
The Rising Star Internship is a structured
