<b>Communication</b>	* Have 2 total communication experiences in the project area. Conference judging is allowed here one time. <b>Workshops</b> (Tours, Field Trips, Camps, Research (Library and/or Computer)	Not required	* Have at least 1	* Have at least 2 total	* Have at least 4 <u>ALL MUST</u> relate to the project area.

\* The requirements for the awards are cumulative . . . so the Bronze requirements also applies to Silver, Gold, etc. You are **adding** to each year.

See the handout Citizenship, Leadership, and Communication for sample ideas of activities in each of these. Think about how you might be able to relate them to your project as needed. In your 4-H Project Record, be sure to expand on these experiences (more than listing what you did).

You may or may not have had an exhibit at the county fair to apply for these awards. An exhibit at county fair is not required. This is only one piece of the overall 4-H experience. You are working on steps to achieve your overall project goal throughout the 4-H year. The write-up completed for fair is about your exhibit goal.
