Remember: the more time you have been in a project area, the more challenging your goals should be and the more learning you should be able to demonstrate.

HOW TO WRITE A 4-H GOAL

A goal has 3 parts. A goal should tell:

1. The **action**: **how** you are going to do it.

2. The **results**: what you will do.

3. The **timetable**: when you plan to have it done.

STATE 4-H RECOGNITION OPPORTUNITIES

State 4-H Recognition is the process in which senior 4-H members in **grades 9-12** can apply to be selected for special statewide opportunities such as awards and trips. The purpose of this event is to provide an avenue for youth recognition and to provide young people with an **opportunity to practice and grow leadership, communications, and college and career readiness skills** through application and interview activities.

Important Dates

- Applications open in 4HOnline on January 1. Interviews may be done in-person or by video teleconference.
- The application deadline every year is 11:59 PM on February 1.
- Interview selection and schedule are announced in the first week of March. Please review the interview times posted below. Time requests and preferences will only be available in 3-4 hour time blocks as listed.
- In-person interviews are available Saturday, March 26, 2022, 9 am-12 pm and 12 pm-3 pm.
- Video interviews will be available on Saturday, March 19, 8 am-12 pm, or Tuesday, March 22, 4 pm-7 pm.
- Awards are announced every year in mid-April.

Are you an Iowa 4-H'er planning to attend college? The Iowa 4-H Foundation knows it's not easy to finance a college education, and we know that many Iowa 4-H'ers can use help achieving their educational goals. Consider applying for an Iowa 4-H Scholarship, funded by donors through the Iowa 4-H Foundation.

Designed to encourage lowa 4-H members to continue their education beyond high school, our current scholarship program offers over **90** scholarships worth more than **\$100,000**. Applications are available on-line and are **due before or on February 1, 2022**. Only one application form is needed for all lowa 4-H scholar-ships. Eligible Iowa 4-H youth may apply for more than one scholarship, however, only one scholar-ship per individual will be awarded per academic year.

DID YOU KNOW?

Project Areas

Each month we will highlight project areas that you might be interested in but didn't know much about!



The mechanics project area examines a range of fields linked to practical applications of power, energy, and electricity. Experience this technology firsthand while increasing technical and scientific literacy, communications, and decision-making skills.

Ideas for this project: Present safety information related to mechanical systems. Understand safety and equipment used in welding. Maintain small engines in your home and garage. Practice safe operations of engines and engine driven systems, including tractors, combines, mowers, and other applications. Experiment with different welds and beads for joints for constructing products.





Music rocks! It's all around us. It's in movies, TV, radio, computers, school, concerts, and just about everywhere! Music sets the mood and is the focus for voice or instrumental performances. Challenge yourself or learn to increase your skill level!

Ideas for this project: Perform your music in different places. Compare how location affects the sound. Trace a musical style such as jazz or baroque. Discover how a genre of music was started and developed over time. Create a poster to promote a musical performance. Organize a talent show. Perform at a community event or a nursing home. Trace the history of an instrument that interests you.

Every year, approximately 700 teenagers

converge on the campus of ISU for 3 days full of speakers, workshops, mixers, dances, a banquet and service-learning activities. If you have completed 8-12th grade, you are eligible to attend! You don't even have to be in 4-H to attend.

You will experience campus life and meet new people from across the state. You will have fun while learning by doing! If you have an interest in animal science, you might want to look into becoming part of the ROUND-UP track! There are also workshop tracks that span all 3 days for certain topics if you'd like to study something in more depth. Or, you can choose different workshops each day to get more variety while you're on campus.

Registration opens March 2022. Registration fee by June 1 is \$180 with a late registration fee of \$200 until June 10. You can also check out financial aid applications through the Iowa 4-H Foundation.


