Swine Weigh-In

Want to show a dairy heifer?

Two new programs were approved by the Tama County Fair Board to promote the opportunity to show a



dairy heifer at the fair. Open to 4-12th graders.

- 1) Leasing Program For 4-H/FFA members who have a dairy connection. Lease agreement will need to be signed by 4-H/FFA member, parent and animal owner. Signed Dairy Cattle Lease Agreement must be turned into the Extension Office by May 15, 2023.
- 2) Share-A-Dairy-Heifer Program For 4-H/FFA members who would like to show a dairy heifer and have a facility to house and care for the dairy heifer but do not have a connection to a dairy producer. This program requires an application and interview/site visit to determine eligibility. Those eligible will be given a dairy heifer to care for and show at the Tama County Fair. Deadline to apply for this is March 15. Contact Sara Forrester for more information (563) 543-6971.

YQCA

Those 4-12th grade members exhibiting beef, swine, sheep, goats, dairy cattle, rabbit and poultry must be YQCA certified by June 15, 2023 in order to exhibit at the Tama County Fair. Can be completed online or at an in person training . **Coupons are available for the in person training by contacting the Extension Office (\$3 value). Every June, approximately 500 teenagers converge on the campus of Iowa State University for 3 days full of speakers, workshops, mixers, dances, a banquet, and service-learning activities.



If you've completed 8th grade, you're eligible to attend. You don't even have to be in 4-H to attend this conference!

You will get to experience campus life and meet new people from across the state! You will be having fun while learning by doing, dancing the nights away, and serving the community. You will get to learn new things to take back to your community and school, and in the process you might even discover something new about yourself! There are opportunities for you to share your talents and meet new people through educational workshops, teambuilding activities, and a talent show.

If you have a specific interest in animal science, you might want to look into becoming part of the Animal Science Round-Up track You get to identify what areas you are interested in for workshops so that each day you get to explore a new topic of learning.
