\* Poultry \* Rabbit \* Sheep \* Swine
\*\*THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BY JUNE 15, 2022 in order to exhibit at the Tama County Fair.

Training must be completed online (cost \$12) There are NO coupons available for online training.

### **Horse Exhibitors**

If you are planning on exhibiting a horse at the Tama County Fair and did not attend the pre-fair workshop held in April, an email was sent with a make up activities. This is due back to the Extension Office by

May 15. Please contact the office if you need a copy of the activities mailed to you.





### **Breeding Heifers**

#### Breeding heifers are required to have a tattoo PLUS one other form of ID.

This can be 1) 4-H tag, 2) Registration number OR 3) Calfhood vaccination number.

If you need help with a tattoo or need a 4-H

tag, contact the Extension Office. Cost for tags are \$2.00.



If you are exhibiting the heifer as registered, the registration number must be entered into 4honline by May 15.

#### **Market Steers**

If you have lost a tag from the December weigh-in, contact the Extension Office immediately. We will get a new tag to you!

### Weigh-ins

If you brought animals to a weigh-in—it is YOUR responsibility to enter into 4honline by May 15.

### **May 15 Animal Identification Complete**

All Clover Kid and 4-H animals must be identified in 4honline by May 15. Only these animals will be allowed on the Tama County Fairgrounds. Make sure to complete all required questions.

Pictures are NOT required this year.

If you are an FFA member who is also in 4-H and are identifying animals FFA—DO NOT put your animals in 4honline. Your FFA advisor will have a paper copy for you.

### **Fair Deadlines**

## **June 15 Fair Entries Due**

#### Fair books will be handed out at your May Club meetings.

#### Included in the fair book is the fair entry form.

Every member (Clover Kids and 4-H) must complete this form to make your fair entries. (If you are in 4-H and FFA—you must complete a form for 4-H entries and another for FFA entries).

Fee is \$1.00 per entry. (Clover Kids—there is no fee).

\*\*\*Remember: Every entry must be written down and paid for (example you are going to bring 4 photos—you must write that down 4 times and pay \$4.00)

Where it says Fair Book Number-that means the class number, not the page number.

The Fair Book and Entry Form is also on our website.

Make sure to double check you have a class for each animal you identified and plan to bring to the fair. If there is not a class listed, that animal will not be allowed to enter the fair.

A County Fair Queen must reside in the county she represents or an adjoining county if the majority of her



activities are in the county she represents. If a fair represents more than one county, the winning contestant must reside in one of the participating counties.

Each contestant must be an active member of at least one service organization in her community such as a church group, Girl Scouts, 4-H, etc. (Eligibility is not limited to 4-H membership.)

Open to all females 16-21 years of age.

There are opportunities for you to share your talents and meet new people through educational workshops, teambuilding activities, and a talent show!
