Market Beef Weigh-in—Save the Date

December 22, 2023 (2:00-6:00 pm) Snow date Dec 22 (8:30 am to noon)

Tama Livestock Auction

**A letter will be mailed on December 1 to all members who are enrolled in 4honline, have paid their enrollment fee AND have entered the beef project in

4honline. If you did not enter it when you enrolled, contact the Extension Office to get your name on the list.

This letter will have all the important information for your weigh-in.

This weigh-in is for market heifers, market steers, and pen of three.

Breeding heifers can come to this weigh-in if they need a tattoo and 4-H tag. **New this year— Breeding heifers must have a tattoo AND one of these other forms of ID—a calfhood vaccination tag OR a EID (840) tag. Registration numbers are required for purebred breeding classes but are not a form of identification. You can purchase the 840 tags through the extension office or use your own.

Bottle calves do not attend any weigh-in but must have a tag (can be a farm tag with a name or number). This tag must be entered into 4honline by May 15th and must match the animal that comes to the fair in July!

Make sure you save the dates for swine weigh-in on March 30 and sheep & goat weigh-in May 4

Swine Grant

The Tama County Pork Producers are looking for 4-H and FFA members (grades 4-12th) to apply for the 2024 Swine Grant.

This grant is for members who have never shown swine before. The grant will purchase 6 feeder pigs, feed and education/support.

Application process includes: An application, essay questions and a letter of reference from your 4-H/FFA leader. All applicants will have an interview with the swine grant committee.

Those selected will attend field trips/meetings, the annual Pork Producer banquet, exhibit at the 2024 Tama County Fair and submit their record book.

It's fall. Make your own apple sauce. More recipes found at https://spendsmart.extension.iastate.edu/recipe

Ingredients

- 4 apples (peeled, cored, and chopped)
- 1/2 cup water
- 2 tablespoons white sugar (optional)
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon (optional)

Directions

- 1. Combine apples, water, sugar, and cinnamon in a saucepan.
- 2. Cover and cook over medium heat for 15-20 minutes or until apples are soft.
- 3. Cool. Mash with a fork or a potato masher.



Do not mash applesauce if you prefer the chunky kind. Can be eaten hot or refrigerated and eaten cold. Apples that are good for applesauce are Gala, Fuji, Braeburn, and Golden Delicious.

ALL animals must be identified in 4honline by May 15, 2024.

Tama County Entries in Fairentry (both livestock and non-livestock) are due June 15, 2024.

YQCA must be completed by June 15, 2024.

<u>Communications</u>—In order to be selected to the Iowa State Fair—you must have given your presentation at your club prior to the fair.

<u>Horse Exhibitors</u> - Are required to attend a pre-fair workshop. Workshop date will be announced.
