Use of ISU Trademark

Are you planning to use an Iowa State trademark in your 4-H project for the county or state fair? Here's how you get permission to show your project! Iowa State's trademarks are very popular, and students will often want to use them in 4-H projects for their county fair. In order for the fair to show and judge your work, they require a letter of permission from ISU. Fill out the form located at https://trademark.iastate.edu/4-h-request. Allow 3-5 business days for a response, in which an electronic version of the letter will be sent to your email. If you'd rather have a paper copy you may request. It is important that this letter of permission be shared with the judge and be placed with your exhibit to be displayed.

Exploring Design Elements and Art Principles

2025 IOWA STATE FAIR RULE CHANGE

The following rule changes will impact all livestock exhibited at the State Fair, but primarily those who enter the IFAA Sale of Champions. Livestock General Rules & Regulations - While on the Iowa State Fairgrounds genetic material cannot be taken from exhibited animals except if needed for official animal verification purposes by the Iowa State Fair or breed organization. 4-H Beef Cattle, Market Heifer - Ovaries and oocytes will not be allowed to be collected from the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Heifers. Exhibitors may still collect genetic material from their animal, but it will need to have been collected BEFORE coming to the Iowa State Fair.



2025 YQCA TRAINING

All 4th-12th grade beef, bucket bottle, swine, sheep, dairy cattle, dairy goat, meat goat, rabbit, and poultry exhibitors are **REQUIRED** to be YQCA certified to exhibit at the Wapello County Expo and/or the Iowa State Fair. YQCA certification is due July 1st, 2025. To be certified youth must have completed an in-person or online training. Once completed, please send a copy of your certificate to Cindy at cemery@iastate.edu. If you still need to complete it—you can get your YQCA certification online at https://yqcaprogram.org/



4-H & FFA EXHIBITOR APPAREL REMINDER All 4-H and FFA members and Clover Kids exhibiting at the Expo are required to wear appropriate attire while exhibiting. This should consist of an approved 4-H/FFA t-shirt, or a white blouse/dress shirt, and dark slacks or jeans. NO SHORTS ARE ALLOWED WHEN EXHIBITING IN ANY DEPARTMENT. Animal exhibitors are required to wear close-toed, hard-soled shoes. 4-H exhibitors may wear a white, gray, 4-H green, or black T-shirt with the 4-H emblem on it. FFA members must wear an appropriate t-shirt with the approved FFA emblem on it. You will not be allowed to exhibit if you are not dressed appropriately. This rule includes Family and Consumer Science/Science and Engineering exhibitors, livestock exhibitors, and pet exhibitors. Horse show attire is listed in the Horse Division. **Royalty sashes, crowns, tiaras, medals, or any type of hat are not allowed to be worn during any exhibit judging




