2025 IOWA STATE FAIR RULE CHANGE

The following rule changes will impact all livestock exhibited at the State Fair, but primarily those who enter the IFAA Sale of Champions. Livestock General Rules & Regulations - While on the Iowa State Fairgrounds genetic material cannot be taken from exhibited animals except if needed for official animal verification purposes by the Iowa State Fair or breed organization. 4-H Beef Cattle, Market Heifer - Ovaries and oocytes will not be allowed to be collected from the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Heifers. Exhibitors may still collect genetic material from their animal, but it will need to have been collected BEFORE coming to

Use of ISU Trademark

Are you planning to use an Iowa State trademark in your 4-H project for the county or state fair? Here's how you get permission to show your project! Iowa State's trademarks are very popular, and students will often want to use them in 4-H projects for their county fair. In order for the fair to show and judge your work, they require a letter of permission from ISU. Fill out the form located at https://trademark.iastate.edu/4-h-request. Allow 3-5 business days for a response, in which an electronic version of the letter will be sent to your email. If you'd rather have a paper copy you may request. It is important that this letter of permission be shared with the judge and be placed with your exhibit to be displayed.

Exploring Design Elements and Art Principles

Fashion Revue: Fashion Revue is for clothing project area members who will model an outfit of one to three pieces that they have constructed, hand-knitted, machineknitted, or crocheted during the current 4 -H year.

\$20 Challenge: The \$20 Challenge is for 4-H members to model an outfit purchased for \$20 or less from resale venues such as garage sales, consignment, or thrift stores, etc., that represents an intended use for the selected outfit. The participant should have had individual or group experiences: choosing shopping alternatives; evaluating fit, quality, and construction features; and comparing prices. A receipt is required.

Clothing Selection: Clothing Selection is for selected or purchased outfits that represent the 4-H member's goal or intended use based on individual or group experiences: choosing shopping alternatives; evaluating fit, quality, and construction features; and comparing prices.

Innovative Design: The innovative design class encourages creativity and out-of-the-box thinking when creating an outfit. These designs can be theatrical costumes, cosplay, wearable technology, sustainable/upcycled fashion, and/or outfits that use unconventional materials. The garment(s) may be modeled by the exhibitor or the individual it was designed for.

*** Bucket of Junk Contact Cindy if you are interested in registering for any or all of these projects.

Your goal is to design an art piece using scraps of metal, your welding ability, and using your creativity. These can be judged as a project and you must complete the general 4-H paperwork. You must contact Cindy to register for a buckets. 1 bucket per team or person. These designs will be auctioned off at the end of Expo. Please let Cindy know by May 15th if you wish to receive a bucket.

*** Bucket of Flowers

The goal is to create a container of flowers to be displayed during Expo to enhance the appearance of the building. These can be judged as a project and you must complete the general 4-H paperwork. You <u>must</u> sign up to participate. Each person may only enter 1 container as a project, but may create as many as you'd like. These will be auctioned off at the end of Expo.

*** Recycled Wooden Chair

The goal is to take an old wooden chair and create a recycled project or projects out of this 1 chair. There are only a couple chairs available. You <u>must</u> sign up to participate. Each person is only allowed 1 chair. Chairs will be available to pick up May 15th. This can be entered as a project in the upcycle project category, you must complete the general 4-H paperwork.

*** Recycled STEM Challenge

Your goal is to create a 3D life-sized plant (example: Corn Stalk or sunflower) out of recycled products. These can be judged as a project. You must sign up to participate. These can be judged as a project and you must complete the general 4-H paperworkThese designs can be auctioned off at the end of Expo or put on display at the Extension Office.





4-H & FFA EXHIBITOR APPAREL REMINDER All 4-H and FFA members and Clover Kids exhibiting at the Expo are required to wear appropriate attire while exhibiting. This should consist of an approved 4-H/FFA t-shirt, or a white blouse/dress shirt, and dark slacks or jeans. NO SHORTS ARE ALLOWED WHEN EXHIBITING IN ANY DEPARTMENT. Animal exhibitors are required to wear close-toed, hard-soled shoes. 4-H exhibitors may wear a white, gray, 4-H green, or black T-shirt with the 4-H emblem on it. FFA members must wear an appropriate t-shirt with the approved FFA emblem on it. You will not be allowed to exhibit if you are not dressed appropriately. This rule includes Family and Consumer Science/Science and Engineering exhibitors, livestock exhibitors, and pet exhibitors. Horse show attire is listed in the Horse Division. **Royalty sashes, crowns, tiaras, medals, or any type of hat are not allowed to be worn during any exhibit judging




