Important Dates:

May 15th: 4-H Online Enrollment deadline- all Clover Kids need to be enrolled to participate at the Fair

June 1st: FairEntry opens

July 19th: FairEntry closes- all projects need to be entered by 11:59pm

July 21st: Clover Kids Sharing Night at the Warren County Fairgrounds from 5:00-7:00pm

The Clover Kids program in Warren County is a 4-H program for children in grades Kindergarten through 3rd grade. The program offers a variety of hands-on experiences suited for this age group. One of the experiences that Clover Kids can participate in is the County Fair. We invite any youth who has enrolled in Clover Kids to participate!

General Guidelines

- All participants must be enrolled in 4-H Online by May 15th. Please go to www.v2.4honline.com to login and view your profile. Status should be "Approved".
- If Clover Kids are participating in the Clover Kids Sharing Night, there is no requirement on attire. Clover Kids shirts are available for purchase at the Extension Office, if you'd like to wear one during judging.
- All entries will be taken online and will open from June 1st through July 19th. All projects need to be entered in FairEntry by July 19th at 11:59pm. We will not be taking late entries.
- Clover Kids competition is non-competitive. Participation ribbons are given, but no premiums will be distributed.

Clover Kids Pet Show

- The Clover Kids Pet Show is on Sunday, July 30th at 9:30am on the Friends of 4-H Stage. Please check in behind the Free Stage with Extension staff starting at 9:15am.
- Entries for this show will close on July 19th at 11:59pm. Late entries will not be accepted.
- When entering your project online, please make sure you put what breed your pet is and the pet's name. A stuffed animal is also an option for those who can't bring their pet.
- Clover Kids will bring their pet on stage and answer questions from a Senior 4-H member in front of an audience. Some questions might be, "What is the name of your pet?" "How do you take care of your pet?" "Does your pet have any tricks they can do?"

Clover Kids Fashion Show

- The Clover Kids Fashion Show is on Thursday, July 27th at 5:00pm at the Friends of 4-H Stage. Please check in on the side of the stage with Extension staff starting at 4:45pm.
- Entries for this show will close on July 19th at 11:59pm. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Outfits must be purchased at a garage sale, consignment store, thrift store, secondhand store, or similar place.
- Twenty dollars is the purchase price limit including tax.
- When entering your project on FairEntry, please make sure to include a write up about the outfit that was chosen. This will be read in front of an audience while the Clover Kid is modeling their outfit on stage. It should include how much the total outfit was.
- An outfit consists of major clothing pieces such as a shirt and pants or a dress. You may add accessories to your outfit outside of your \$20 budget. The Clover Kids are able to pick out any type of outfit; formal, casual, sporty, etc.

Clover Kids Sharing Night

- Clover Kids Sharing Night will be on Friday, July 21st from 5:00-7:00pm at the 4-H Exhibit Building at the Warren County Fairgrounds.
- Exhibitors may bring up to 4 projects to share with the judges. Please make sure that all projects are entered in the FairEntry system by July 19th. No late entries will be accepted.
- All projects will need a Clover Kids entry tag. These will be printed for you and available for pickup at the Warren County Extension Office during business hours or at Clover Kids Sharing Night. These tags will need to be attached with string or tape.
- Clover Kids will have a chance to share their projects with the judges. The judges might ask them questions like, “What was your goal while making this project?” “Will you use this project after the Fair?” “What was your favorite part when making this project?”
- Once they are finished sharing, Clover Kids will attach a ribbon on their project and place them on their Club Booth. Projects can be picked up on Sunday, July 30th from 9:00-10:00pm or Monday, July 31st from 9:00-10:00am at the 4-H Exhibit Building.
- Please see the Static Projects section for more information on what static projects Clover Kids can enter.

Bucket of Junk Workshop

- The Bucket of Junk Workshop will be held on Monday, July 10th from 5:00-6:00pm at the Warren County Extension Office.
- Registration will be required to attend this workshop. It will be sent out via email and social media sites.
- Clover Kids will make a project out of random art supplies supplied by the Warren County Extension office. Glue and tape will be allowed.
- This project will stay at the Extension Office and will be displayed at the Warren County Fair in the 4-H Exhibit Building.
- You will not enter this project into FairEntry and it will not count towards your 4 projects.

Static Projects

- Ag and Natural Resources: Items related to plants, agriculture, and the environment. If you are bringing a plant, please note that it is your responsibility for its care.
- Creative Arts: Items related to original art projects, and music.
- Family and Consumer Science: Items related to food, clothing, or home decorating.
- Personal Development: Items related to stories, poems, or citizenship and civic engagement.
- Photography: Printed photographs or collages.
- STEM: Items related to mechanics, automotive, woodworking or robotics.

Open Class Exhibitors

If you would like to enter livestock projects or any other culinary, textiles, creative arts, and horticulture projects they are considered open class. Please note, youth will not be showing as Clover Kids, but as open class exhibitors. Any questions on open class rules, guidelines or divisions will need to be directed towards the Warren County Fair at 515-961-6687 or 515-961-5861 (during fair week).
