Virtual 4-H Clothing Event Class Options

**you may participate in all three*

Clothing Selection: 4-H'er models a garment purchased from any source and describes to the judge why the particular outfit was selected. Can be clothes for any event: sports, casual, work, bed, formal etc.

Fashion Revue: 4-H'er models a garment he or she constructed, hand-knitted, machine-knitted, or crocheted during the 4-H year and describes to the judge why the particular fabric, pattern, design, etc. was selected.

\$15 Challenge: 4-H'er models an outfit purchased from a second-hand store, such as Goodwill, Salvation Army, garage sale, etc. that costs \$15 or less. This does not include shoes, accessories, or undergarments. Receipts must be turned in with report form.

Participants need to complete forms for each class they compete in. Juniors and Intermediate age divisions use the same report form. Seniors (grades 9-12) use a different form. All Clothing Event Report Forms can be found under "Clothing Events" at <https://www.extension.iastate.edu/washington/>

VIDEO COMPONENTS

Runway footage of 4-Her modeling outfit:

- Standing still
- Walking several feet
- Slow turn

Then have an assistant ask these questions for the 4-Her to answer on camera:

- Why did you pick clothing as a project this year?
- What do you like best about your outfit?
- What design elements can be found in your clothing project?
- How does your outfit make you feel?
- What was the most challenging part about your clothing project?

July 18, 2020

Written feedback and ribbons will be mailed. Judge's division comments will be recorded and posted on YouTube.

Clothing Contest Videos due July 8

1. Log into Fair Entry at <https://washingtoncounty.fairentry.com> Help sheets are available on the Fair Forms website at <https://www.extension.iastate.edu/washington/page/2012-washington-county-fair> or contact the Extension Office for help
2. Select age division (Jr, Int, Sr) classes (\$15 Challenge, Clothing Selection, Purchased)
3. **Create runway video that includes answers to the "On-Camera Questions".**
**The judges will want to see how you look and move in your outfit.
4. Upload final video to YouTube.
5. Copy and paste YouTube link in the description box of your entry on Fair Entry by July 8th.
