Basic Project Requirements for Record Book **Project Awards**

<p>Project Goal All project areas must have a goal. 4-H'er may or may not have reached their goal for the year. 4-H'ers must have one project goal.</p>	<p>0 pts No Project Goal</p>	<p>1-5 pts Goal is weak or is missing information Goal does not show a timeline of events 4-H'er is not in control of the goal (i.e. I want to win Grand Champion this year).</p>	<p>6-10 pts Goal is project related Goal shows how, when, why Goal is age appropriate Goal shows a timeline Goal passes control test (4-H'er has control over the goal) 4-H'er has more than one project goal.</p>
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<p>Project Learning 4-H'er must show learning in each project area.</p>	<p>0 pts No learning involved</p>	<p>1-5 pts Learning is vague. Doesn't connect goal to learning involved.</p>	<p>6-10 pts The 4-H'er has shown growth in the project area. Links project to citizenship, leadership and communication outcomes. Shares experiences/learning with others. Growth is evident by the learning involved.</p>
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<p>Project Worksheets 4-H'ers should include project worksheets for both livestock and static exhibits. Members may use worksheets provided or come up with their own format.</p>	<p>0 pts No project worksheets included.</p>	<p>1-5 pts Project worksheets incomplete No financial records No pictures Missing information</p>	<p>6-10 pts Project worksheets show financial information 4-H member has included pictures to show learning process involved. Project worksheets/records show that the 4-H'er demonstrated goal-centered learning. 4-H project worksheets are neat and complete. Project worksheets are age appropriate.</p>
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
