

2023 YQCA TRAINING - DUE MAY 15TH

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) training is available online or in person at scheduled trainings. This certification teaches youth ethical and proper care of animals entering the food chain.




All 4th-12th grade beef, bucket bottle, swine, sheep, dairy cattle, dairy goat, meat goat, rabbit, and poultry exhibitors are REQUIRED to be YQCA certified to exhibit at the Winneshiek County Fair and the Iowa State Fair. YQCA certification should be completed by May 15th, 2023.

To be certified youth have the following options:


- Complete YQCA certification online at https://yqcaprogram.org/. Materials and modules are organized by grade. There is a \$12 fee paid online when you register for the online course. Youth are welcome, by appointment, to test at the Extension Office with our laptops and internet if needed, however, a parent would need to provide payment information for the online payment.
- Exhibitors are also welcome to take an instructor led training. Registration can be completed at https://yqcaprogram.org/. Registration and \$3 payment are required online before coming to the training. Instructor led trainings are available on:
 - Sunday, March 12th at 5:30 PM at the Ossian Community Center
 - Tuesday, March 28th at 6:30 PM at the Winneshiek County Extension Office
 - Thursday, April 6th at 6:30 PM at the Winneshiek County Extension Office

2023 MARKET BROILER REGISTRATION - DUE MARCH 15TH




Do you have an interest in poultry or interested in learning more about poultry? If you are the Broiler Project is an opportunity for 4-H or FFA members to gain valuable experience in raising chicks to broiler-weight through partnership. Luzum Brothers Poultry serves as a sponsor for the Market Broiler Project. The sponsor will purchase the chicks and the 4-H/FFA member is responsible for whatever is necessary to raise the chicks to healthy broiler weight and processing of the birds. Market Broiler letters will be sent in February to those enrolled in the poultry project. The Market Broiler Order form will be due by March 15th to the Winneshiek County Extension Office.

2023 MARKET SHEEP & GOAT WEIGH IN

The 2023 Market Sheep/Goat weigh in will be held on Saturday, May 6th from 8-11AM in the show barn at the Winneshiek County Fairgrounds. Information letters will be sent to members signed up for the sheep and/or goat project area in 4HOnline prior to weigh-in.














INNESHIEK COUNTY FAIR LIVESTOCK REQUIREMENTS



There are four important things to remember if you want to exhibit at the 2023 Winneshiek County Fair.

- 1) Weigh-ins: Attend weigh-in for your species. Market Beef December 2022, Swine -March 2023, Sheep and Meat Goat - May 2023. Pay attention to State Fair requirements for retinal imaging or DNA samples.
- 2) Livestock ID's: Market Beef ID's are due in 4HOnline by February 1st. All other animal ID's are due in 4-H Online by May 15th.
- 3) **YOCA:** (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) certification is required by May 15th for 4th-12th graders who intend to exhibit animals that could enter the food supply.
- 4) **Fair Entry:** Due on or before June 15th for all livestock.
- **Watch your monthly 4-H newsletters and mailings for information regarding the above items. It is your responsibility to read the 4-H newsletter and other mailings in order to remain up to date with any information involving fair. If you have any questions please call us at 563-382-2949. **
