**PINEBLUFF  
4-H CAMP**



**Pinebluff 4-H Camp** includes 115 acres of pine covered bluffs, beautiful trails, overnight lodging and a scenic river located near Decorah in Winneshiek County.

**Pinebluff is a non-profit** camp owned and operated by Winneshiek County 4-H Foundation in cooperation with ISU Extension and Outreach, Winneshiek County.


It is a camp for youth and adults alike. The camp is used as a retreat site for 4-H activities as well as family reunions, celebrations and numerous other outings. The camp is available for both daily activities and extended camps.

**The camp is located** on the scenic Upper Iowa River. A swinging bridge offers an adventurous trip over the river and provides access to hiking on beautiful trails that are surrounded by nature, forests and wildlife habitat. The Upper Iowa River also offers tubing, canoeing and fishing.

**Camp facilities include** an open air lodge with attached kitchen facilities with hot and cold running water. Picnic tables are located under a covered area open on three sides. A fireplace is also located here.

**Pinebluff has 4 cabins** (3 shown below) housing approximately 10 beds each and a bathroom facility with warm showers.

**Three of the cabins** will accommodate 10 campers each and one cabin will accommodate 16 campers. Bunks and mattresses are provided, but campers must bring their own pillows, sleeping bag or other bedding materials.

**Restrooms are located** near the cabins and have sinks, showers and hot and cold running water. Campers should bring their own towels, soap etc.

**A playing field provides** ample space for volleyball, softball and other outdoor activities. Inner tubes and life jackets are available for use. There are campfire rings located in designated areas that provide a place for a perfect end to a day of fun and learning.

**Pinebluff is currently** for warm weather use only. The camping season is from mid-April through October.

Pinebluff is approximately 8 miles northeast of Decorah on River Road (Third bridge northeast of Freeport.)
