## **Boone River Ox Bows Lakes Area**

Participants will tour a row crop farm that has installed ox bow lakes near the Boone River watershed. Specialists will discuss end of field conservation practices and management of watershed in row crop and pasture situations.

## **Lost Lake Farm**

A unique dairy and cheesery with a herd of grass-fed dairy cattle, milk from 24 cows is turned into artisan cheese and sold locally. Tour participants will learn about cheese production and sample the niche products.

## **Three Sisters Farm**

Learn about organic sheep production along with predator and pasture management. We'll enjoy a catered lunch on the farm. Speakers will discuss water and soil management practices including strip tillage, bioreactors, buffer strips and cover crops.
