

# Food Safety Quality Assurance (FSQA) Workshops

Important information if you plan to exhibit at County Fair, State Fair or Clay County Fair

## Requirements:

4-H'ers in grade 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, & 6<sup>th</sup> must attend workshop every year (see below for workshop dates)

4-H'ers in grade 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> can attend a workshop but it is recommended you test out

4-Hers in grade 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, & 12<sup>th</sup> must test-out - anyone who is in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade on January 1, 2013, will take the test. Testing dates have not yet been set.

The FSQA Workshop is required for 4-H'ers who are in 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grade as of January 1, 2013, and who plan to exhibit the following animals at the Woodbury County Fair, Iowa State Fair and Clay County Fair: **Beef (market steer or heifer, breeding, feeder calf or cow/calf), Dairy Cattle, Goats (Dairy and Meat), Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep and/or Swine.**

4-H'ers who are in 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Grade as of January 1, 2013, and plan to exhibit any of these animals: Beef, Dairy Cattle (market steer or heifer, breeding, feeder calf or cow/calf), Goats, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep and/or Swine, you have the option of testing out or attend a FSQA workshops. It is recommended that you test if you are in grades 7-9 as of January 1, 2013. You will not have to test out again until you are in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade. **Testing dates have not yet been set.**

4-H'ers who are in 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Grade and older as of January 1, 2013, MUST take the test. When you test out that will be the last test you will need to take. **Testing dates have not yet been set.**

**Workshop Dates: If you are currently enrolled in 4-H you must attend one of the following workshops. The only exception are for 4-H'ers who join after April 15. There are 5 workshops that 4-H'ers may attend. Monona and Ida County have invited Woodbury 4-Hers to attend their workshops if the Woodbury dates conflict with other events.**

Must pre-register by March 1 - Limit to the first 20
- Saturday, March 9, 9:30 am – 11:30 am at a location in Merville  
Must pre-register by March 7 - Limit to 40
