



## WOODBURY COUNTY RECORD KEEPING PROJECT AWARD GUIDELINES - GRADES 4-8

These awards are divided into three categories: **Green, Blue** and **Purple**. Listed below are the minimum requirements for project awards for 4-H members in grades 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. The award application can be up to 4 pages of the requirements listed below with an additional 2 pages or less of support materials (resume and/or photos). Recognition Team and other individuals will read through your application and award your application(s) with a green, blue or purple.

2. State your project goal(s) for specific award area. The goal contains an action (how), the result (what) and timetable (when). Example: I want to train my 4-H calf to lead by fair time.	Required	Required	Required

4. Write and explain about a citizenship activity(s) that you participated in with your club or as an individual (Examples: help set up/take down the meeting room, helped at the fair, made gifts for Senior Citizens, clean up the fair or road ditch, participated in a food drive). 5. Write and explain about a leadership activity(s) that you did in your club (Examples: held an office, served on a committee, helped with a fundraiser, led the 4-H pledge, helped a 4-H'er with their project, made and brought treats to meeting, gave your idea at a meeting). 6. List communications activity or activities. (Examples: gave a talk at your club about your project, visited with a judge about your project, made a poster about your project, displayed your project at school, took pictures and shared with club, gave a presentation).	Required	Required	Required
