

# 2019 Club Booth Assignments in 4-H Building

## Put the Booth Number on your Hang Tags

Each 4-H Club is assigned a Booth Number to help 4-H Superintendents and Judges keep track of projects. Each 4-H project in the 4-H building must have a 4-H Hang Tag with the booth number.

### Hang Tags

4-H'ers must have a hang tag on each project. The booth number needs to be written on each hang tag. Your leader will have hang tags or you can pick up tags at the Extension Office. Hang tags will not be available on judging day at the fairgrounds. **Hang tags must be on the project before coming to the fair.**

The Blue Hang Tags are for 4<sup>th</sup> graders and Clover Kids (and FFA). The White Hang Tags are for 5<sup>th</sup> – 12 graders. Use a black felt tip marker to mark the booth number on your hang tags and to fill out the information on the tag so that the public will clearly see who the project (s) belong too.



### Booth Information – Helpful information if you are decorating your booth(s)

Sizes of the booths are 8 ft with two 4 foot sidewalls, height is 72 inches (6 ft.).

Double booths are 24 ft with two 4 foot sidewalls, height is 72 inches. The pegboard goes down to the floor. Tables are built into each booth and table can fold down if not needed. For clubs with just a wall, a table will be provided if needed. **Please do not sit on the tables attached to booths!**

***Be careful about copyright and the use of the 4-H Clover!***

**What to use in the booths – there is no theme, each club may decide their own decorations.**

We want to keep the booths clean and tidy for many years. Some items leave a mark or residue.

**Do Not Use:** Duct tape, scotch tape, packing tape, no staples, no glue and no thumb tacks (tacks are ok if put into the wood, but NOT the pegboard).

**You can use:** poster putty, masking tape, zip ties/twist ties, wire, command strip or binder clips
