Identify your Animals and Livestock by May 15

4-H animals and livestock must be identified in 4-H Online...no paper forms will be accepted from 4-H families (FFA students will still need to fill out paper forms). If 4-H families do not have a computer or internet access, you are welcome to come into the Extension Office to enter your animals. If office hours don't work, please make special arrangements.

Go to 4-H Online at: <https://iowa.4-Honline.com/> - this is the same site that you used to enroll in 4-H. If your address or email has changed, please contact the Extension Office first.

All animals that 4-H'ers want to exhibit at the County Fair, State Fair, Clay County Fair and Ak-Sar-Ben (and for other shows that required animals to be identified) must be identified on or before **May 15 by 11:59 p.m. to be eligible to show.**

Animals that are required to be identified by the 4-H'er in 4-H Online are:

- Breeding Heifers
- Cow/Calf Pairs
- Feeder Calves (4-H'ers will first need to pick up USDA tags from the Extension Office)
- Dairy Cattle
- Dogs (current rabies vaccination) (picture required for state fair, optional for county fair)
- Goats (dairy goats and fancy goats that are already tattooed)
- Horse (will need 4 pictures: front, back and both sides required for state fair, optional for county fair)
- Llamas /Alpacas
- Poultry (not required for County Fair)
- Rabbits (only identify for State Fair and Clay County)
- Swine (4-H'ers will first need to pick up USDA tags from the Extension Office) Notches required.

Animals that were weighed in at an official weigh-in site do not need to be identified by the 4-H'er in 4-H Online, those animals include: Market Beef, Market Sheep, Meat Goats and Pig-of-Merit. Families will need to verify their information in 4-H Online. This is a requirement for 4-H'ers showing at the Iowa State fair.

This includes all livestock, horses, dogs, poultry and rabbits (and communication form). 4-H Dog Obedience Classes

4-H Dog classes, with your dog, will be held from 6:30 - 8:00 p.m. at the Fairgrounds in Merville Iowa. Dates include June 4, 11, 18 and 25 and July 2, 9, 16, 23 & 30. Besides obedience there will be handling and rally information. Please bring proof current rabies and vaccinations to the first class.

4-H dogs must be identified in 4h Online at <https://iowa.4honline.com/> by 11:59 p.m. on May 15.

4-H'ers may enter two dogs in the obedience classes if the dogs are in different classes. If you have any questions and need more information on the 4-H Dog Program, please contact 4-H Dog Superintendents, Jill Tentinger at 712-898-1895 or Jamie Johnson at 712-253-3336.

Feeder Calves need an official 4-H tag

4-H'ers planning to exhibit feeder calves at the Woodbury County Fair, Clay County Fair and Ak-Sar-Ben must be tagged on or before May 15. Tags must be the official USDA tag. Feeder calves must be identified on or before May 15 in 4-H Online by 11:59 p.m. Go to 4-H Online at: <https://iowa.4honline.com/>

Tags are available at the Woodbury County Extension office and cost \$1.00 per tag.

County Fair Pigs

4-H and FFA members planning to exhibit swine at the Woodbury County Fair must tag their pigs using the Iowa USDA tag. Cost of the tags are \$1.00 per animal. Tags can be picked up at the Woodbury County Extension office. Families MUST indicate how many tags and the name of the 4-H'ers using the tags. All unused tags MUST be returned by May 15. All pigs must be tagged by the 4-H family on or before May 15.

All pigs for county fair must also have ear notches. The tags and notches of each pig must also be entered in 4-H Online: <https://iowa.4honline.com/>

Rabbit Tattooing | June 19 from 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. @ Fairgrounds

4-H'ers exhibiting rabbits at the Woodbury County Fair must have their rabbits tattooed. For those without tattoo equipment, a tattooing date is set for June 19 from 6 p.m. – 8 p.m. at the Woodbury County Fairgrounds. 4-H Rabbits for the Iowa State Fair must be identified by July 1 and entered online.

Pullorum Testing for Poultry | June 25 from 4:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

All poultry exhibited at county fair must come from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks (this means the location where your poultry is housed is NPIP certified (National Poultry Improvement Plan) or have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of public exhibition and the test must have been performed by an authorized tester. The majority of 4-H members who exhibit poultry will not be NPIP certified and will have to have their birds tested if they plan to exhibit at county fair. The county testing date will be held on Sunday, June 25, 4:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. at the Woodbury County Fairgrounds. There is no cost for 4-H members.

4-H members may have another Iowa certified tester test their birds, which needs to be done within 90 days of the county fair. For a list of testers, contact the Iowa Poultry Assoc. at: <http://www.iowapoultry.com/>.

Only official paperwork from a tester will be accepted for entry at the Woodbury County Fair. You must ask for a certificate when your purchase your birds from a pullorum-typhoid free flock.

FSQA Workshop or Testing Dates for 4-H'ers showing Livestock

FSQA (Food Safety Quality Assurance) REQUIRED TO EXHIBIT AT FAIR

4-H members exhibiting Beef (market, breeding, cow/calf and feeder calf), Dairy Cattle, Goats (Dairy & Market), Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep & Swine **MUST** either attend a workshop or test-out if you exhibit at the Woodbury County Fair and/or the Iowa State Fair.

4-H'ers in 4th, 5th, or 6th grades **must attend an FSQA workshop**. Only one workshop left. **Monona County has one more workshop that you can attend; but space is limited. You must call to reserve your spot.**

LAST WORKSHOP: Monona County 712-423-2175 - Please call Monona to register as space is limited.
May 6, FSQA workshop at 9:30 a.m.—11:30 a.m. Onawa – Fairgrounds

Afterwards 4-H'ers are welcomed to attend a free lunch and Animal Workshop. Open to all 4-H'ers.

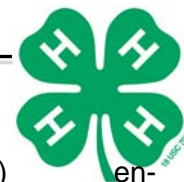

Entries are due in 4-H Online by 11:59 p.m. on July 1. 4-H'ers must be currently in 5th – 12th grade to exhibit at the Iowa State Fair in 4-H. There is also a pre-order for admission tickets.

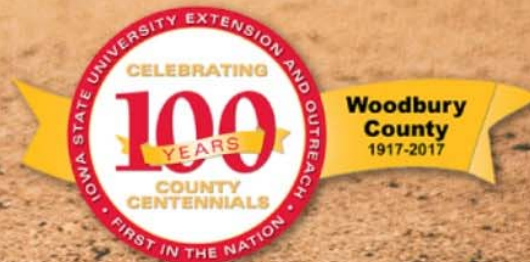
