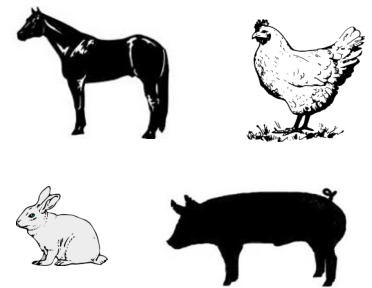


Livestock Clinic
