If you did not attend the in person training in January, you will need to complete the training in 4-H Online.

#### **Past Volunteers:**

- 1. Send <a href="mailto:pstewart@iastate.edu">pstewart@iastate.edu</a> your full name and email and she make sure your background check is up to date. If it has been over three years Paige will send you a new background check to your email. (The email will come from First Advantage)
- 2. Go to 4-H Online <a href="https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in">https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in</a>
- 3. Enroll in 4-H Online for the 2023/2024 4-H year if you haven't already.
- 4. Sign into your family 4-H Online Account.
- 5. Click View to access your profile page.
- 6. Click **Trainings** on the lower left-hand side of the screen.
- 7. Click **Register** in the right-hand corner.
- 8. Click on Annual Leader Training 2023-2024.
- 9. Click Register in the bottom right corner.
- 10. Click Annual Leader Training 2023-2024 (It will say incomplete next to it)
- 11. Click Creating a Vibrant 4-H to gain access to the training.
- **12.** Complete the training as instructed in 4-H Online. Once finished, your account will show that you have completed the training.


